Stay at Home Kit

- **Fuel up your vehicles**
- **Bring in ALL outdoor furniture and other loose items.**
- **7 days of non-perishable food.**
- **One gallon of water per person and day.**
- **Cash**
- **Medicine**
- **Battery powered portable TV or radio with extra batteries**
- **Flash light with extra batteries**
- **First aid kit**
- **Sanitation and hygiene items (hand sanitizer, moist towelettes, toilet paper etc)**
- **Whistle to signal help**
- **Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities (water, electricity)**
- **Manual can opener**
- **Rain gear**
- **Matches in a plastic bag**
- **Fire extinguisher**
- **Important family documents (ID, bank records, insurance policies)**

To Go Bag

- **Fuel up your vehicles**
- **Important family documents (ID, bank records, insurance policies)**
- **Radio with extra batteries**
- **Extra mobile phone charger**
- **First aid kit, flash light and whistle**
- **14 days supply of medication**
- **Sanitation and hygiene items (hand sanitizer, moist towelettes, toilet paper etc.)**
- **Rain Gear**

Remember: If you evacuate the authorities decide when you can come back to your house.
